ORDER

Local Rule 2090-1 is hereby amended to include subsection (c), which reads as follows:

- (c) Any member of the bar of the Supreme Court of the United States, any United States Court of Appeals, or any District Court of the United States who is a nonresident of Oklahoma may be admitted to the bar of this Court for limited practice upon written application. Limited practice shall be restricted to appearance and practice in a case or proceeding then on file in this Court. Attorneys requesting such admission are required to attach to their application a completed Request for Admission *Pro Hac Vice* form provided by the Court Clerk's office along with a required fee in such amount as to be fixed by the Court.
